Mandatory Qualifications</u></p> <p>(i) A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate, including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects as under:- TGT (English): English as an elective subject at Degree level. TGT (Social Studies): Any two out of History, Geography, Economics or Political Science, of which one must be either History or Geography. TGT (Maths): Maths with any two out of Physics, Chemistry, Electronics, Computer Science or Statistics. (TGT (HWT): Diploma in Counselling from a Teacher recognised University or BA/ BSc Psychology with Educational Psychology/ Counselling Psychology from a recognised University or MA/ MSc in Counselling Psychology or MA MSc Psychology with Counselling Psychology as specialisation or MA/MSc in Applied Psychology with Counselling Psychology from a recognised University.</p> <p>(ii) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education. However, B.Ed. degree is not mandatory for the post of TGT (Computers), TGT (Music), TGT (Games), TGT (Drawing) and Health Wellness Teacher.</p> <p>(iii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.</p> <p>(iv) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.</p> <p>(v) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Mandatory Qualifications</u></p> <p>(i) Graduate Degree, with a minimum aggregate of 50 percent, from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/AICTE. The Graduate Degree should be in any one of the subjects taught in the Middle/ Primary classes of that Air Force School. Those holding a graduate degree in any other subject will not be eligible. However, if such candidate holds a Masters Degree in any of the subjects taught in the School, he/she will be eligible for the post.</p> <p>(ii) Professional Qualification. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/ National Council of Teachers Education.</p> <p>(iii) Experience: Teaching experience of at least two years as a PGT/ TGT/PRT or at least three years as a NTT or experience of at least two years as Principal/HM of an Air Force School.</p> <p>(iv) Age</p> <p>(aa) Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled. There will be no upper age limit in the case of serving staff of Air Force Schools but they should have at least two years of residual service as on 01 July of the academic year in which they are being considered for the post.</p> <p>(ab) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.</p> <p>(ac) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. OR</p> <p>(ii) 12th passed and 1 year diploma in Special Education(DSE) in any of the category of disability. OR</p> <p>(iii) Diploma in Community based Rehabilitation(DCBR) with 6 months certificate course in education of Children with Special Needs. OR</p> <p>(iv) Post Graduate diploma in Community based Rehabilitation (PGDCBR) with 6 months certificate course in education of Children with Special Needs. OR</p> <p>(v) Diploma in Multi Rehabilitation Worker (MRW) with 6 months certificate course in education of Children with Special Needs. OR</p> <p>(vi) Junior Diploma in teaching the Deaf. OR</p> <p>(vii) Primary level Teacher Training Course in Visual Impairment. OR</p> <p>(ii) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and four-year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) Mandatory Qualifications</p> <p>(a) Graduate from a Govt recognised University.</p> <p>(b) Typing speed of at least 40 wpm in English.</p> <p>(c) Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.</p> <p>(d) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.</p> <p>(e) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.</p> <p>(f) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. 		<p>age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.</p> <p>(d) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit.
